Zero Period: Occasional before school practices at 7:30am are scheduled by Mr. Saliby

during marching season. This is the only opportunity for the whole band

and color guard to practice marching together.

Performances: Placentia Heritage Day Parade, El Dorado Football Game, PYLUSD Band

Pageant, Breakfast with the Band, and Knotts Berry Farm. For these various performances, we will be performing with the band and traveling

by bus to get to and from each location.



Winter Guard

Winter Guard season begins at the end of November and lasts until the end of the school year. We do not perform with the band which allows us to focus on creating a dynamic show that challenges the students as performers. During this time we will learn a routine that focuses on building color guard skills and adding in rifle basics. This is a more competitive atmosphere where we will be performing at various competitions in the WGASC organization.

We will have a separate tryout for the winter guard season where I will expect all students to confidently be able to perform these various basics.

Dance: Able to march in step and perform with enthusiasm and energy. General understanding of dance basics.

Only a handful of students will be selected for the winter guard season. I will be looking for students who are active participants during the colorguard season and show a passion for the sport. These basics listed above will be taught throughout the color guard season. If students practice during practice time and at home, these basics should be able to be confidently executed. Come time for the winter guard audition, failure to be able to perform these color guard basics can jeopardize your chances of making the winter guard team. By selecting students who demonstrate these qualities I will be able to create a better performing experience and produce choreography that will challenge these students in their color guard careers.

Attendance

Attendance is incredibly important throughout the school year. I only have 4 hours a week with your kids and I try to use every second of that time to its fullest. While I love my time with your kids, I understand that conflicts will arise during the school year. If there is ever a time in which a child needs to leave early or can not attend a practice then an email or text message must be sent to me prior to the day of the practice. Failure to do so would lead to an unexcused absence. If a child accumulates 4 unexcused absences then they risk the privilege to perform. It is not fair to have a child perform if they can not perform at the level of their peers due to a lack of attendance. These policies apply to both zero periods and after school practices. The practice before a performance is mandatory in order to perform unless discussed with me prior.

Rehearsal Dress Code

- Athletic attire (all attire should be age appropriate)
- Close-toed tennis shoes or sneakers
- Hair must be pulled back into a ponytail, bun, or braid
- No sandals, No dresses/skirts, No jeans, No loose or dangly jewelry
- Students may wear regular school attire to zero period
- Mask -- must be worn throughout practices until further notice

Performance Dress Code

I will review performance attire, hair, and makeup before every performance.

Grades

Grades are checked prior to our Knotts Performance and Winter Guard tryouts. Students with "D's" or "F's" are not permitted to attend.

Behavior

We practice with a good attitude and a smile on our face. During my practices, I do not allow any bad attitudes or unsporting behavior. If these actions are shown this would lead to dismissal from practice. It is also my goal to promote a drama free zone both in and out of practice. As a team, it is every individual's responsibility to support one another. Any behavior that is un-teamlike to another member or directed to another school will lead to immediate dismissal from the team. This includes actions taken both in person or online/social media.

Summer Camp

To be successful, we begin our training over summer. At Summer camp, students will learn a small routine to perform for family and friends. Attendance is mandatory unless previously discussed with me. During this time equipment will be distributed to all students. Rehearsal dress code must be followed and it is encouraged for all students to bring water and a snack. Most importantly this is a time for the team to bond and get to know one another before the school year.

Student Responsibilities

- -Learn, memorize, rehearse, and perform various skills and routines.
- -Drop off equipment and rehearsal clothes in the TMS band room BEFORE school begins, or immediately after school. Do not drop off during class. It is disruptive.
- -At our various events, students must stay together at all times.
- -Come to rehearsal fully prepared: have equipment taped appropriately and meet the appropriate rehearsal dress code. Failure to comply will constitute dismissal from rehearsal. (Purchase black electrical tape at Home Depot.)
- -Rehearse at home to maintain good skills. It is very easy to spot the students that are not rehearsing at home. Aim to be the best you can be!
- -Use equipment in designated practice areas and under adult supervision.
- -Abide by school regulations. (no foul language, no use of drugs or alcohol, follow school dress code)
- -Students that are not a part of our program are not allowed at our rehearsals.
- -Do not allow non-guard members to use your equipment.
- -Students that are enrolled in band <u>and</u> color guard must rehearse with color guard after school, but perform with the band since it is part of your band grade. Band will not interfere with winter guard performances.
- -If you are involved in other school activities you must inform me.

Parent Responsibilities

- -Have appropriate paperwork on file in the office and be covered by insurance.
- -Parent involvement is encouraged. Show your support.
- -Parents are asked to encourage at home practice and to encourage their children to project a good image in all areas for TMS.
- -Help your student keep his/her commitments and accept responsibility.
- -Help your student with school and class responsibilities.
- -Listen for and/or read all announcements for important information relating to color guard and winter guard activities.
- -Help students to maintain a "C" or better in each class. Citizenship must be satisfactory or outstanding.
- -Communicate with me! This is our key to success! With so many members it is absolutely necessary to stay in good communication.

Communication

Email is my number one form of communication. I actively check our email and will be sending out emails to the entire team regarding practices, performances, and needed updates throughout the school year.

The other platform I will be using is an app called BAND App. The Band app is an all in one platform for groups that has various features such as a communication board, calendar, and folders for sharing pictures. I highly encourage everyone to join, even if you do not have a cell phone, you can still join through their online platform. This platform will not be my main source of communication but is a wonderful tool.
